#### **Cross Country Tournament**

Following the cancellation of the cross country tournament organised by Ringmer Primary School last month due to poor weather, we have been kindly invited to participate in the rescheduled tournament which will take place on the afternoon of Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January. The event will take place on the playing field at Ringmer Community College and the course will be approximately 1.6km of flat terrain. There will be separate races for boys and girls with children from Years 4, 5 and 6 able to take part. This is a team competition and the first four girls and the first four boys from each school will score. Parents will need to transport their child/children to the event, leaving Alfriston at 1pm to arrive at Ringmer by 1.30pm and then take them home when the event finishes at approximately 2.30pm. Children will need to wear their PE kit, take a water bottle and a warm top and trousers in case of poor weather.
