Easter Church Service and End of Term Arrangements

On the final day of term, tomorrow, our day will end with an Easter Service at St Andrew's Church, Alfriston, at 2pm. This will be led by the children in Sapphire Class but all classes will be involved in the service. Parents, family and friends are welcome to join us for this event. If any parents are able to help walk the children down to the church, leaving school at 1.30pm, then please leave a message at the school office. It will be assumed that all children will be collected from the church after the service, unless a reply slip asking for them to be returned to school for collection has already been handed into the school office, and that also included the children who usually use the minibus or taxi. Please note that children do not need to bring book bags to school. Also, please can children who have packed lunch bring their lunch to school, for this day only, in a plastic bag that can then be thrown away at the end of lunch. Children in Sapphire Class should come into school tomorrow dressed in their Easter production costumes. All of this is to reduce the number of items that need to be taken to the church. The cloakroom areas will be cleared at the end of today and the children's PE bags will be sent home then as they will not be needed on the final day.

Late and Attendance

Staff and governors are concerned about the number of children coming to school late. Therefore, from after Easter, as well as Cool Cat and Fang which the children achieve for the class with the best attendance and being on time on a weekly basis, there will be an additional reward break for children who have no lates and another reward break for those with 100% attendance across the whole term.
