# **Census Day**

Next Thursday, 18th May, is national School Census Day. The Government currently funds a universal infant free school meal for children in Key Stage 1 and the funding for these meals is based on the number of infant children who have a school meal on census day. The school only receive funding for the amount of free school meals actually eaten on census day. Consequently, if your child doesn't have a school meal on this day, but does on any other day within the school year, the school must fund the school meals from our teaching and curriculum budget. We are keen to avoid this especially at a time of challenging budgets. Therefore we would like to see as many children as possible from Pearl and Ruby Classes having a school meal next Thursday. To help with this, our meal provider, Chartwells, has decided to offer a special, popular menu to the children for lunch. The meal choice for Census Day is: BBQ chicken pizza or macaroni cheese served with oven baked potato wedges, fresh carrots and fresh broccoli or a jacket potato with a choice of fillings or a tuna or egg baguette with a side salad or vegetables of the day. Dessert options are a biscuit with banana slices, fresh fruit or yogurt. If you would like your child/children to have a school lunch on the 18th, please advise the school office by 9am on Wednesday, 17th May.

We are allowing children in Sapphire and Emerald Classes to have a school meal and enjoy this special menu as well if they would like. If they usually have a packed lunch, please send in £2.10 per meal to the school office in an envelope with your child's name by 9am on Wednesday. If your child usually has a school meal on Thursdays, then there is no need to do anything.

#### **Swimming**

We are very grateful to Mr McDonald, our pool manager, and Mr Gown, our caretaker, for their hard work in preparing our pool for the swimming season. Final preparations are taking place now so that the children can start to swim on Monday. Please refer to the previous swimming letter for all the details but as a reminder Emerald Class swim on Mondays, Sapphire Class on Tuesdays, Pearl Class on Wednesdays and Ruby Class on Thursdays. Please also remember that if your child suffers from any sickness and/or diarrhoea at any point during the swimming season that you must notify the school office and your child will be unable to swim for 2 weeks from the last date of such an illness.
