Pupil Premium

Have your personal circumstances changed?

Are you unemployed, long term sick or a single parent?

If you are in receipt of any of the following :-

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7,400 or less)
 - Income support
 - Income-based job seeker allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, only, if your annual household income isn't over £16,190

You may be entitled to Pupil Premium support.

This does NOT affect any of your benefits but allows the school to access extra funding for your child, to support them with visits and any curriculum needs they may have. It also entitles them to a free school meal which you may or may not wish to take up.

Successful Grant Application for Alfriston Village Playground!

Congratulations to the Friends of Alfriston Playground. Their grant application to Veolia Environmental Trust for the renovation of Alfriston Playground has been successful. Once financial agreements are signed, the trust will provide £57,200, and combined with a grant from East Sussex County Council, funds from Alfriston Parish Council, funds raised at community events and donations from individuals and businesses, will give them enough for the new playground. The playground, which has been designed with input from the community and its children, will enable safe and fun play, will provide a social hub for families of the Cuckmere Valley, and will also host a family Nature Club run by volunteers. The community has really pulled together to raise funds for the project, and the Friends of Alfriston Playground are really grateful to everyone who has helped and got involved, as well as this generous funders.
